Paying per capita is similar to:

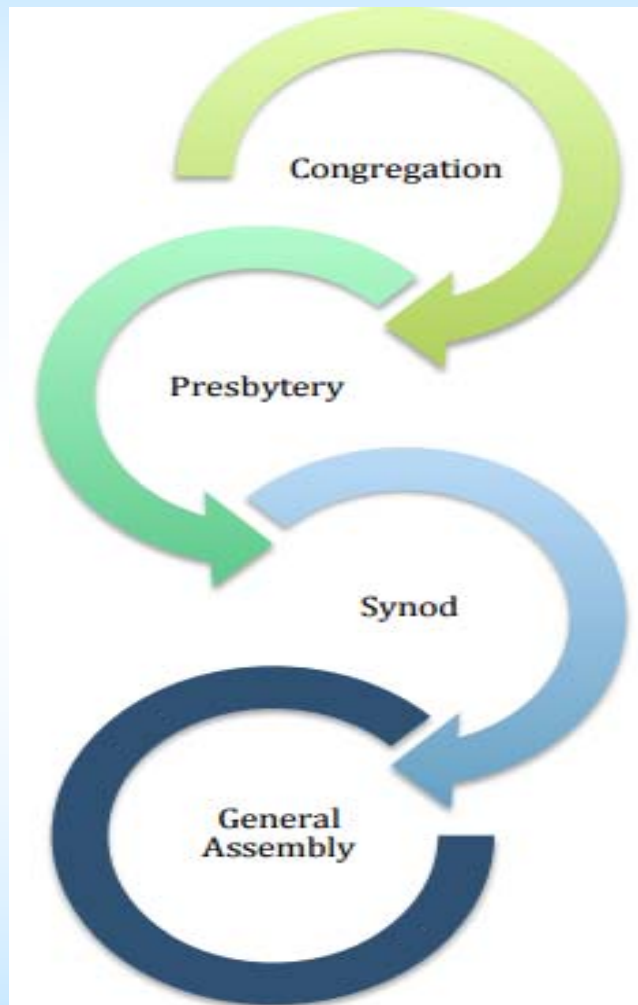
- . Contributing one's dish to a potluck meal*
