



As you probably know, following the recent guidance from the CDC, Governor Carney has provided new guidance for mask wearing and distancing. **At this time masks will still be REQUIRED.** We realize that the new guidelines will make many happy—and we know that some folks, especially those at home who are hesitant to return, will not be totally comfortable with these changes. Plus families with children are still carrying a high level of concern since most children and youth are yet to be vaccinated. While there is very little concern about transmission of the virus from those who have been vaccinated, there is, of course, still a concern that children and youth could be infected by persons who are not vaccinated.

Beginning this Sunday, this is what we will do:

- The pews on the organ (left) side will continue to be marked off in 6 -foot distances between family units. Please ask to be seated in these pews if you are hesitant about the new social distancing guidelines.
- The pews on the piano (right) side will be "open pews," and those who feel comfortable with the new guidelines are welcome to use these pews.
- Those attending in-person at worship are invited to sing hymns, with masks on.
- **Masks will continue to be worn by everyone.** The pastors and the Session will continue to monitor ongoing guidance regarding mask wearing to determine the best path forward.

Visiting will continue to happen in outside areas, and we ask you to not congregate in the narthex or lobby for the time being.
